The Outward Bound Trust is an educational charity that helps young people defy their limitations through learning and adventure in the wild.

Our fundraising team raises over £4.5m a year. This provides bursary support for disadvantaged young people to attend our residential courses – and for capital requirements across The Trust. The team of 15 are based at either head office in Hackthorpe, Cumbria; London or Glasgow.

Purpose of the job

Outward Bound is 80 this year and we are launching an 80th anniversary campaign to help us fast track our recovery from the pandemic and reach the young people who need us the most right now. This campaign will involve a number of key initiatives, including high value events. By September 2023, we want to be serving well over 25,000 young people a year with one of life-changing courses. Growing our donor base is key to delivering these plans.

In order to achieve this, we must enhance our research capacity. High-quality research is essential in the recruitment and retention of donors. Our goal is to increase our pool of supporters to provide the voluntary funding we require, particularly from High Value Individuals, but also Corporates and Trusts & Foundations.

This is an exciting opportunity for a creative and self-motivated individual to help build a prospecting programme within a national charity to help meet our fundraising goals.

Job description

In a nutshell....

As Researcher and Major Gifts Executive you'll be responsible for helping gather intelligence and data to enable us to implement and move our fundraising campaign to the next level.

Your responsibilities will include...

- Research and identify significant numbers of prospects of high net worth individuals to support the work of The Outward Bound Trust.
- Gather and manage information on prospects for support of Outward Bound.
- Research and develop a file of donors and prospects.
- Contribute to and identify major giving opportunities.
- Develop and contribute to proposals and report on Outward Bound strategies.
- Work with the Head of Major Gifts, Director of Development and Big Rappel Project Lead to identify future support, especially from high net worth individuals
- Ensure compliant collation of information in line with GDPR regulations
- Provide briefing papers for senior members of staff
