OBJECTIVE

- Explore a variety of leadership styles and support graduates to identify appropriate contexts for applying them.

SOLUTION

- An outdoor business simulation to explore situational leadership and personal behaviours
- A series of self-directed, experiential challenges to develop creative approaches to leadership and bringing out the best in others. This is followed by a coaching session, with the opportunity to give and receive feedback to enhance self-awareness
- A day-long wilderness journey to assess the impact of how our own motivation, behaviour and identity affect those around us and the overall team performance.
- Sessions to ensure the graduates' continued development and the transfer of learning to the workplace.
